Purpose

Uses

- Management of decubitus ulcers.
- Forms protective barrier and speeds healing by increasing capillary blood flow into the ulcerated area.

Warnings

- Keep out of reach of children.
- For external use only.
- Flammable. Do not expose to fire or open flame.
- Do not puncture or incinerate can.
- Intentional misuse by deliberately concentrating and inhaling the contents can be harmful or fatal.
- Avoid spraying in eyes or nostrils.
- Use only as directed.

Directions

- Shake can well and hold approximately 12 inches from area to be treated, press valve and coat rapidly.
- Apply three times daily to areas prone to or exhibiting evidence of tissue breakdown.
- PRODERM serves as its own protective barrier; therefore, additional bandaging is not required.

Other Information

- Gentle massage of the area immediately surrounding the problem area by or under the direction of professionally trained personnel greatly enhances the effectiveness.
- Do not store at temperatures above 120°F.
